# From October 2023 to January 2024

On-line sessions: A first sequence of lectures and tutorial classes to acquire the methodology for team working, followed by three sequences of teamwork (1) to discover the egg sector, (2) to design and realise experiments "at home", and (3) to prepare a debate on a controversial question.

# 5<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> February 2024 in Rennes, France

Physical mobility: In the morning, learn more on the egg sector and the challenges it faces, egg marketing and consumer's perceptions, hen reproductive physiology, egg microbiology, genetic selection and breeding of laying hens, egg processing, nutritional and functional qualities. In the afternoon, visits to exchange and interacting with professionals (experimental research, breeding, genetic selection company, egg packaging and egg processing industry), and practical works to address egg quality. On the last day, a workshop to imagine together the future of the egg sector.
