Hvanneyri Campus (West-Iceland)	Main campus is situated at <u>Hvanneyri</u> where most of the university teaching takes place, approximately 80 km from Reykjavik and 15 km from the town of Borgarnes (bus connection between Reykjavík and Borgarnes exists).	
Keldnaholt Campus (Reykjavík)	There is no grocery stores in Hvanneyri and no public transport to and from Hvanneyri. Students have to arrange their own travels. The International office is assisting with arrival and departure. There are always possibilities to arrange rides with local students to Borgarnes where all supplies are available. Very recommendable for exchange students to bring a own car (Ferry from Denmark).
