Mendel University in Brno

MENDELU was founded in 1919 and proudly bears the name of J. G. Mendel, the founder of modern genetics. There are over 8,300 students at the University, 1,600 of them are international students.. The University offers more than 100 different graduate degree programmes in Czech and in English.

The University comprises of:

- Faculty of AgriSciences
- Faculty of Forestry and Wood Technology
- Faculty of Business and Economics
- Faculty of Horticulture
- Faculty of Regional Development and International Studies
- and Institute of Lifelong Learning.

The modern university campus is based in Brno, the second largest city in the Czech Republic - the heart of Europe. Brno is considered one of the best student cities as it is listed in the 2018 Top 10 QS Best Student Cities as rated by students.



Nomination and Application Procedure

Incoming students must be nominated by their university coordinator (student's name, DOB, e-mail address, passport number, area of study, and desired semester) together with the following documents by e-mail:

- Application Form
- Motivation Letter
- Curriculum Vitae
- Transcript of Records
- English Certificate
- Copy of valid passport

Visa

Students from non-EU countries are required to have a long-term visa or a long-term residence permit for the purpose of study in order to travel to the Czech Republic.

Insurance

Students with a long-term visa need to arrange the emergency travel medical insurance, students with a long-term stay (residence permit) need to arrange comprehensive/complex travel medical insurance.

Letter of Acceptance

If the student is accepted for an exchange programme, International Relations Office will send him/her scanned copy of Letter of Acceptance. Original together with Accommodation Contract will be sent to the International Coordinator at partner university. Cover letter will be sent to the Czech Embassy/Consulate in your home country.

Transcript of Records

All exchange students can download their online transcript after the semester ends at the University Information System. Those who need an original ToR please contact the IRO before departure to the home country.
