# THE WONDERFUL WORLD OF WEEDS

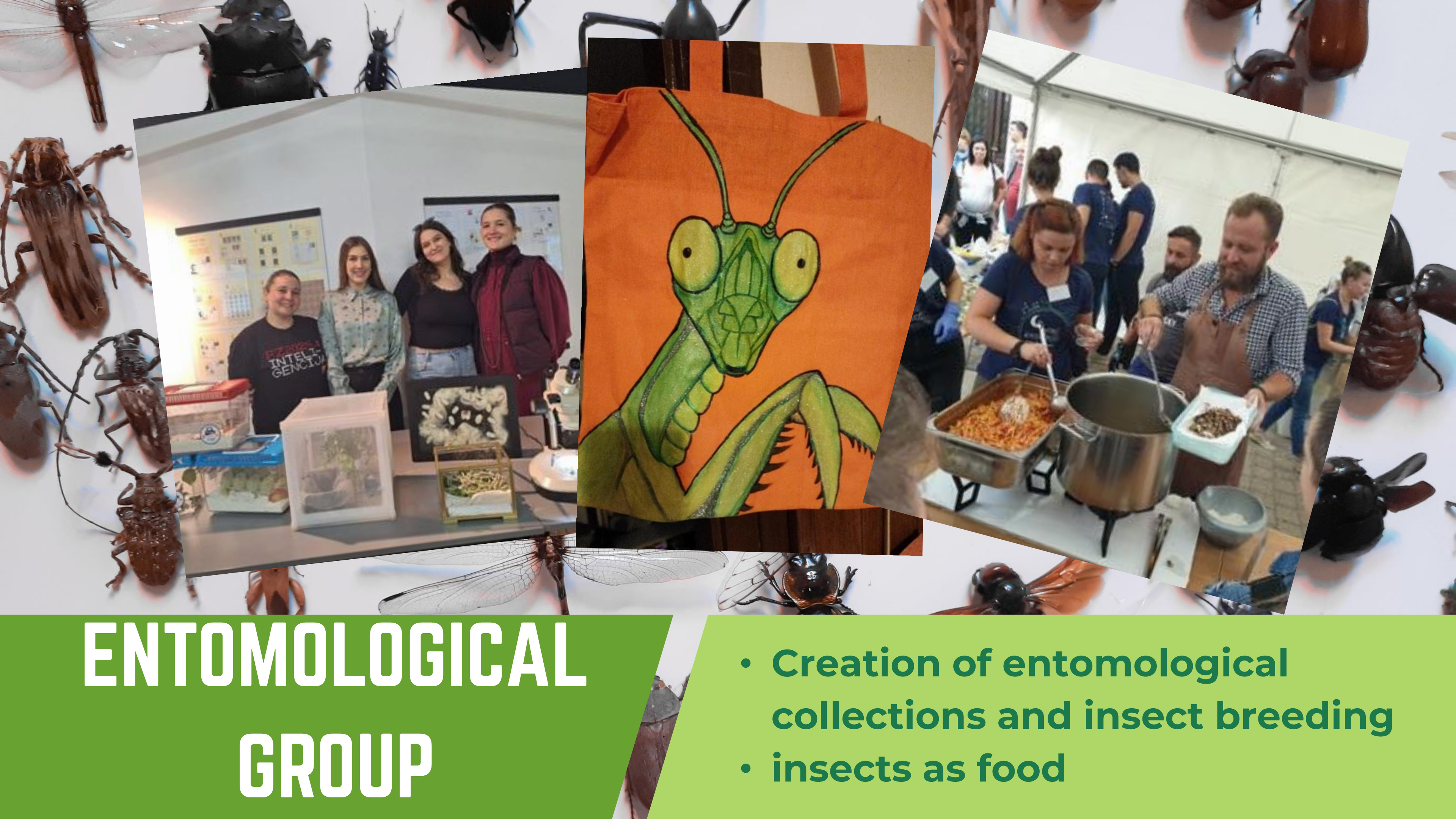


- Artistic, scientific, expert and educational section
